Sub: M.P.V. Act, 1952 - and the Scheme framed thereunder-levy of damages of defaulting employers under Section 14-B of the Act-Regarding.

Ref: This office circular No.C/MD/OPN/Regl/62 dated 17/29.12.62

Your kind attention is invited to this office circular mentioned above wherein the rates at which damages will be collected for the delay in remittance of the Employees' Provident Funds Dues, was communicated. The Government of Madras, Department of Industries, Labour & Co-operation, have issued the following further orders in respect of the levy of damages under section 14-B of the Employees' Provident Funds Act 1952.

(1) Five days of grace will be allowed to the employers for payment of provident fund contributions and no damages will be levied for remittances made before 20th of the following month.

(11) For delays upto fifteen days, including the five days of grace, damages at half the rates laid down in this office circular cited, will be levied.

2. It is hoped that the factories/establishments will utilise the above relaxation sparingly and will endeavour to make remittances on or before the 15th of the month following the one to which the remittance relates as prescribed in para 38 of the Employees' Provident Funds Scheme.
